OUT OF OFFICE ADMINISTRATION OF ALLERGY EXTRACTS

We understand your desire to have allergy extracts administered out of our office. These must be given at a medical facility. The person administering the injection must be a physician, physician assistant, nurse, or medical assistant trained in handling severe allergic reactions. This would include, but not limited to administering epinephrine injections, performing CPR, and the ability to reverse a reaction as it is developing with appropriate medical care.

There are some potential side effects/reactions associated with the administration of allergy extracts. Examples of immediate types of reactions include generalized hives, wheezing, difficulty breathing, difficulty swallowing, and in extreme conditions, shock or possible death. Local reactions may include swelling, redness and soreness.

Once an allergy extract is taken out of our office, we believe the person administering the allergy injection must assume all responsibility for any side effects associated with the administration of the allergy extract.

The physicians at Boulder Valley Asthma and Allergy Clinics, PC (BVAAC) are available to work with your physician at any time. As a patient, I realize a check-up every 6 months is required.
